Call Your Pediatrician

- You are **worried** and aren't sure what to do next
- Cough, congestion, runny nose, sore throat
- **Fever** (even >103) *in child over 2 months old*
- Vomiting/diarrhea, possible dehydration
- Simple injuries, cuts, splinters and sprains
- Minor animal bites, minor burns
- Ear pain, ear infection or sinus infection
- Headache, body aches or belly pain
- Allergies and/or rash/hives
- Stitch/staple removal

The Office is Closed and You are Worried

- 1 *First:* Call your pediatrician to speak with the **On-Call service**
- 2 *Second:* Consider **Urgent Care Center**

Go to ER or Call 9-1-1 (and call your Pediatrician)

- **Difficulty** breathing (persistent)
- Seizures
- **Uncontrolled** bleeding
- **Ingested** a poison, drug or unknown substance
- **Serious** injuries (visibly broken bones, unconsciousness)
- **Major** burns
- **Fever** (over 100.4) *in infants under 2 months old*
